COMMITMENT BRINGS PERSECUTION

When Christians in the first century made a commitment to follow Jesus they would learn that discipleship was not going to be easy. Soon they would be driven from their homes and separated from families. They would flee for their lives and lose contact with their local congregations, Christian brothers and sisters who meant so very much. Many would become martyrs. They needed to keep their priorities clear and firm. Whatever was in first place must stay in first place! Only the challenge of Jesus would sustain them in every trial, persecution or separation. Their driving motivation would be: "Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness" (Matthew 6:33). Armed for such a mission they "went everywhere preaching the word" (Acts 8:4). They were to be His "witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria and the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8).

GOD'S FELLOW WORKERS

Those who made financial sacrifices to send out missionaries became spiritual partners with them. Supporters at home may not have been required to pay the ultimate price, but they could pray for those who would die for the Faith. Together they were "God's fellow workers" (1 Corinthians 3:9) It is true today as it was then: prayerful, generous contributors are essential to the success of the "great commission". STRASBOURG, FRANCE



"Evgenia, a refugee from the Russian-speaking part of Ukraine, came to our door seeking a place to stay. Her situation is very sad. She left everything behind and brought only one suitcase. She didn't spreak French, English or Spanish, and we don't speak Russian. My hope was to evangelize Evgenia, but without the ability to communicate it was very, very difficult. We helped her with food, shelter, clothes and administrative proceedures. Evgenia has now moved closer to people who speak her language. We hope she will rememer the Lord's church was there for her. We continue to help a sister in the church whose husband kicked her out. She is a refugee from Africa, and is showing great strength in her faith. This is an opportunity to touch lives of her two young children. We continue to study the Scriptures with two Gypsies who are Pentecostals. I also met a high school boy, Fabio, and talked to him about God and offered him a Bible. The next day he had several questions, like: "What type of mate does God want me to choose?" "What does it mean to sin?" "HOW CAN I get rid of my sins?" "What does it mean to be baptized?" Finally, I was operated on recently for a herenia. I am slowly recovering, but it has been most painful. We are deeply indebted for the way you are supporting us through your prayers and financial contributions. None of what we are doing here would be possible without you. May the Lord bless you."


